



## **Don't Confuse Spokane Todd with Facts**

Spokane Todd and his Renewable Resources Coalition would have you believe that fishing and mining can't co-exist. He's clearly never been to the second-largest salmon producing system in the world –B.C.'s Fraser River – where not one of eight active and 64 historic mines has ever been shown to have had a negative impact on Canada's largest salmon fishery.

One mine near the Fraser River is the Gibraltar copper mine, managed by a sister company of Northern Dynasty. It's operated safely and without incident since the early 1970s – with ZERO impact on nearby fisheries.

Here's another fact Spokane Todd isn't telling you: The Gibraltar Mine is six times closer to the Fraser River than Pebble would be to the Kvichak River and 10 times closer than it would be to the Nushagak River.
